If you live in Illinois and are - or know someone who is - currently involved in a divorce proceeding or contemplating filing for divorce, changes in the tax law could affect your case or situation. Currently, an individual who receives alimony payments must report them as income on his or her tax return and pay taxes on them. The individual responsible for paying the alimony to a former spouse is allowed, however, to deduct these payments from his or her taxable income.

Beginning on January 1, 2019, the new tax law will significantly affect
